Position Overview

In addition to coaching responsibilities, the Masters Coach will also serve as the Boathouse Manager supporting the operations of the Club with a focus on boathouse oversight and equipment management.

The Masters Coach reports to the Director of Rowing and plays a key role in growing the VBR Masters rowing program. The ideal candidate is an enthusiastic and collaborative leader who can inspire athletes of all abilities, promote technical excellence, and cultivate a positive, inclusive team culture. This position plays a central role in developing athletes, fostering an inclusive and positive team culture, and strengthening member engagement. Key Coaching Responsibilities

- Lead, organize, and run structured Masters practices in a safe, motivating, and positive training environment.
- Design and implement seasonal training plans that support technical development and performance goals across a wide range of skill levels.
- Provide high-quality technical coaching both on and off land.
- Mentor and oversee contract coaches as needed.
- Offer individualized private lessons for athletes seeking additional instruction.
- Strengthen the Masters community through active engagement, communication, and support for social and team-building activities.

Boathouse Manager Responsibilities:

- Sit on the Operations Committee which oversees safety, building and equipment oversight, and boathouse technology.
- Manage Boat House maintenance issues and coordinate repairs
- Maintain digital communication channels
- Manage third-party relationships & contracts
- Manage conference space
- Manage building entry logistics (key fobs, etc.)
- Assist the DOR with visiting team logistics

Equipment Management

- Fleet Management
- Manage rowing equipment maintenance and repairs
- Maintain inventory of assets for insurance

Qualifications

- Strong understanding of rowing technique, training methodology, and safety best practices.
- Demonstrated coaching experience with Masters or adult athletes.
- USRowing Level 2 Certification or higher preferred.
- CPR/First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain).
- Availability for early morning, evening, and weekend practices and events.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
